

## **Minutes**

### **GSS Special Session, Sept. 21, 2006**

Executive members and Dean Rozek were reintroduced.

#### **Petition for recognition from student groups**

Mike Rueschman, speaking as chair of the Organizations and Allocations committee, reviewed the petitions from student groups seeking recognition. He moved that all be approved, the motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Mike Ackerman requested that we research what students are receiving V-fund awards, specifically, which departments are these students in and are those departments active in GSS.

#### **2006-2007 budget**

The budget was discussed, with the general consensus that increasing spending from \$20k annually to \$30 this year was a good thing, and increasing disbursements to student groups and V-fund awards is a goal worth pursuing. The motion to accept the budget carried 19:1:0.

#### **Bylaws Revisions**

With little discussion, a motion to accept all changes to the bylaws *except* those pertaining to a change in the activity fee was made and carried 19:1:1

The change to the activity fee was discussed, with arguments for a maintaining a flat rate and changing to a percentage of a tuition credit. Raising the fee to cover this year's proposed expenditures, \$30k, versus increasing the fee beyond this point were debated. A motion to accept the .85% of one credit was made, seconded, and carried 19:4:0

Dan Lin requested that we obtain figures on the activities the undergraduates host.
